We encourage colleagues from health and social care to join us as we explore the developments around the legislation supporting the Children and Families Act 2014.

The focus of the day will be upon meeting the challenges of the SEND legislation in respect of the Local Offer, the Schools Offer and Joint Commissioning through service delivery.

- **Brian Lamb** will lead the day looking at implications of the Act on outcomes for children and young people with sensory impairment and the professionals supporting them . He will focus on Joint Commissioning and the Local Offer for schools and services
- David Couch will look at service structures and delivery to support the SEND reforms
- Ros Kendrew will use the NatSIP Quality Improvement pack to explore how services can self and peer assess their delivery
- **Lindsey Rousseau** will give an update on the work of NatSIP and recently published guidance. We will also explore ways that NatSIP North colleagues can participate in the workstreams as a follow up to the last NatSIP North event.

- NatSIP Quality Improvement pack for service self review and assessment (Ros Kendrew)
