This study day/workshop is being hosted by Services in the North East working with NatSIP Workstream 4.

It is aimed at staff working in schools supporting children and young people with HI, VI and MSI; subject leaders, ToDs, QTVIs and QTMSIs in classroom and visiting teacher roles.

This study day/workshop will highlight the recent changes to curriculum subjects and assessment, and the subject-specific workshops will discuss the implications for those with sensory impairments.

The subject specific workshops will also develop guidance on access strategies to be used by professionals with the students they support. This will be available at a later date on the NatSIP website as an e-document. The information will help secure better outcomes for children and young people with sensory impairment.

We encourage staff working in support services to come and contribute to this essential piece of work. You will have the opportunity to gain a thorough understanding of the currently changing and challenging situation in the delivery of the curriculum, and also contribute to the production of vital information to share with colleagues nationally.
