

Quality Assurance and Service Self-review Regional Workshops

In the spring of 2014, the National Sensory Impairment Partnership and the National Deaf Children's Society are offering a new workshop that will help you improve provision for children with sensory impairments by looking at service self-review and quality assurance tools.

These workshops are for Heads and senior managers of specialist education services for children with SI, to reflect on self assessment and quality assurance on delivery of services within a changing context.

We will be sharing a self-review tool and materials which could assist in self or peer review. The materials have been brought together by a NatSIP working group of HoSS colleagues.

People from the same service may wish to attend as an opportunity for service development.

The day will enable reflection, practical discussion and networking opportunities.

At the end of the day you will have:

- a copy of the self-review materials to help you to review your service
- a good opportunity to discuss and share quality assurance processes with colleagues managing other services
