

VI Leadership Training for Heads of Service with an HI or MSI background

Tuesday 23 – Wednesday 24th September 2014 Friends House, Euston Road, London NW1 2BJ

This event is for Heads of Service and senior managers in sensory impairment support services who hold the mandatory qualification in hearing impairment or multi-sensory impairment.

The objective of the course is to improve knowledge about vision impairment to enable leaders and managers of services to secure better outcomes for children and young people with vision impairment.

The course trainers, Rory Cobb (RNIB), Brian Perry (NatSIP Associate) and Judy Sanderson (VIEW), have a wealth of practical experience of working with children and young people with VI and of leading service development

The programme will include:

- an overview of vision and vision impairment
- analysis of current placement trends
- clinical and functional assessment
- the impact of a vision impairment on effective learning
- strategies to support learning and improve outcomes
- the specialist curriculum
- habilitation
- implications and quality improvement for support services

The course will start at 10.30 on Tuesday 23 September and finish at 16:00 on Wednesday 24 September 2014

The cost of the course is £255/delegate discounted to £150/delegate for bookings from NatSIP affiliated organisations.
